# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED AS MEMBERS OF THE ETHEKWINI MUNICIPAL PLANNING TRIBUNAL

In terms of Chapter 6, Section 35 of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act, Act No. 16 of 2013, the eThekweni Municipality established a Municipal Planning Tribunal to consider and decide land development applications assigned to it in terms of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act, Act 16 of 2013 read with the eThekweni Municipality Planning and Land Use Management By-Law 2017 (Municipal Notice 114 of 2017).

The eThekweni Municipal Planning Tribunal was established for an initial period of 3 (three) years, which terms of office expires on the 31 August 2018.

In terms of Section 39 of the eThekweni Municipality Planning and Land Use Management By-Law 2017 (Municipal Notice 114 of 2017), the eThekweni Municipality therefore invites nominations for external persons to be appointed to the Municipal Planning Tribunal for its second term of office from the following disciplines:

- A registered planner who has experience in Strategic Planning
- A registered Planner who has experience in the submission of land use applications

The members of the Tribunal shall hold office of a maximum period of 5 (five) years.

Nominees must be persons who have knowledge of and practical experience in spatial planning, land use management, traffic engineering, and land development or the law related thereto; and must possess the relevant qualifications and professional registrations.

Nominees must strictly be South African Citizens or permanent residents in the Republic who are not disqualified to serve as directors of companies.

Each nomination must be in writing and must include the full names, address, contact details and motivation by the nominee for suitability for membership to the Municipal Planning Tribunal, accompanied by the nominee's identity document, Curriculum Vitae and certified copies of qualifications and registrations.
