Road Safety Poetry and Prepared Speech Competition

The background

The ETA in collaboration with SARF is conducting the Primary schools' Road Safety Poetry and prepared speech competition for all primary schools within eThekweni municipality. The objectives of the competition are to promote good Road Safety practices amongst the learners in primary schools and to support and complement the Curriculum Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS) on the Road Safety education and delivery in schools.

Who may enter?

Learners from grade 2 to grade 7 under the following categories

Category 1 Poetry: Grade 2 -3

Category 2 Prepared Speech: Grade 4 – 7

Category 3 Poetry: Learners with Special Educational Needs (LSEN) on the Mild Intellectual Disability (MID) category

How does it work?

This competition will be adjudicated at two levels, the first one being the school level where the school adjudicates and then forwards the finalists to the next level where adjudication will be done by the SARF and ETA officials.

Selection procedure

Due to a large volume of entries anticipated, a selection procedure will apply and this includes:

- A **one page essay to be prepared by the school** on the Roads Safety concerns around the school and the interventions that the school has conducted in order to address them
- Participation in the workshop to be held in January 2019 and the venue to be confirmed.

Prizes

A total of **R30 000** sponsored by SARF will be given directly to the winning schools and learners as prizes and will be allocated in the following way for all three categories:

1st Place R3000 for the Learner + R4000 for the school

2nd Place R2000 for the Learner Only

3rd Place R1000 for the Learner Only
