SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ABOUT ALL SNAKE SPECIES FOUND WITHIN THE ETHEKWINI MUNICIPAL AREA (EMA).

The Environmental Planning and Climate Protection Department (EPCPD) aims to conserve biodiversity and the ecosystem services it provides for the benefit of present & future generations. In 2017, the EPCPD produced the first Biodiversity Strategy for Durban which outlines eight broad goals to achieve the vision of the strategy: "To undertake targeted communication, education and awareness initiatives and programmes to promote biodiversity and ecosystem service conservation in the EMA." To this end, the EPCPD undertakes to produce relevant educational resources relating to various aspects of biodiversity in Durban to make these available to interested individuals and organisations. The EPCPD has identified a need to produce an educational resource relating to snakes of Durban due to the fact that the available information is incomplete or not easy to access.

The department seeks to appoint a service provider who will provide written information about all the snakes of Durban as well high resolution images for the purpose of producing educational resources e.g. booklets, pamphlets & posters.
